AWARDS & PRIZES

INDIVIDUAL AWARDS

Awards will be presented to Top Two high scorers in Trap, Archery and Rimfire. Pin prizes will be awarded for Men's Long Drive, Women's Long Drive, Longest Putt and Closest to the Pin.

TEAM AWARDS

Team scores will be based on a combination of shooting and golf scores.

1st Place: Plaques + \$2,000 Cash Prize

2nd Place: Plaques + \$1,200 Cash Prize

3rd Place: Plaques + \$400 Cash Prize

BIRDS

OVERALL RULES

- Absolutely no alcohol allowed on the premises of the McKenzie County Sportsman's Club.
- Ear and eye protection must be worn at all times and will be provided for your convenience.
- All personal firearms must be kept in a case or on a rack and unloaded when not in use.

ARCHERY

Each team member will shoot 10 arrows at 80cm bullseye targets using Genesis bows provided by the 4-H Badlands Archery Club. Max 100 points per individual; max 400 points per team.

RIMFIRE

Each team member will shoot 5 spot targets at 30-40 yards; 5 rounds shot in each position: standing, kneeling, sitting, and prone. Each team gets a box of 100 rounds of ammunition to be used in .22 caliber rifles. Scoring will be 5/4/3/2 points. Max 400 points per team.

TRAP

Each team member must bring their own shotgun. Each will receive 1 box (25 rounds) of ammunition. Each team member will shoot a full round of 25 for trap. Each bird broken will score 4 points. Max 100 points per individual; max 400 points per team.

ADDITIONAL GAMES

There will be optional side games for shooters to enter for cash buy-in.

BIRDIES

18-HOLE MAX BOGEY GOLF SCRAMBLE

Each 4-person team will play in a 18-hole max bogey golf scramble.

ADD-ONS

Money Ball: Teams can purchase a numbered ball for \$50. The ball is to be played throughout the course. If a team has the ball at the end of the scramble, the ball will be placed into a drawing for a prize. Teams may purchase one ball.

Mulligans: Teams can purchase up to two team mulligans for \$20.

Course Games: Longest Putt, Closest to the Pin, Longest Drive (Men's and Women's)
